

TUESDAY 23RD FEBRUARY 2016 MARKET REPORT

On a sunny Tuesday at Malton there was a good entry of stock across all departments with a good range of all types and weights of clean cattle. Heifers again averaged over 205ppk and some very good butchers steers topped 209ppk. Hogg numbers continue to rise with an excellent show of sheep on the day.

11 steers averaged 187.32ppk and topped at 229.50ppk (£1495)

4 young bulls averaged 164.75ppk and topped at 198.50ppk (£1375)

24 heifers averaged 208.69ppk and topped at **257.50ppk** (£1372)

12 OTM cattle topped at **208.50ppk (£1366)**

4 YOUNG BULLS

Fewer bulls on offer this week with more needed please. The top price per kilo went to an excellent BB from J & AM Craggs of Ebberston, weighing 610kg and selling for 198.50ppk (£1211) to R Agar of Ilkley. The top price per head went to another BB from the same home, weighing 665kg and selling for £1320 (198.50ppk) to Cleveland Meat Co of Stockton on Tees. A 1000kg Stabiliser Bull from Knapton Wold Farm of West Knapton reached £1375 (137.50ppk).

11 STEERS

There was a slight increase in the number of steers this week including some 'butchers' steers on show. The top price per kilo went to an excellent Lim from MD Medd of Sawdon, weighing 605kg and selling for 229.50ppk (£1388) to A Kitson of Hutton Rudby. The top price per head went to a BB steer from the same home, weighing 675kg and selling for £1495 (221.50ppk). The top price per head went to a Lim from the same home, weighing 585kg and selling for £1372 (234.50ppk) to D Cammish of Drifffield. A Lim from DR Jackson & Sons of Carnaby, weighing 555kg, sold for 237.50ppk and a BB from the same home reached 221.50ppk (£1362). A 14 month old Lim from TJ & S Maw & Son of Thornton Dale, weighing 530kg sold for 208.50ppk.

A slight increase in the number of OTM cattle on offer this week with the top price per head and per kilo going to an excellent 32 month old Lim from G Stainthorpe of Sneaton, weighing 655kg and selling for 208.50ppk (£1366). A 106 month old CHX cow from B Eddon of Pickering, weighing 745kg reached 116.50ppk (£868). A 70 month old AA bull from D & MR Fargher of Bulmer, weighing 1240kg sold for 104.50ppk (£1296). Holstein cows remain a decent trade with well fleshed cows in most demand. The top price Holstein cow was a 118 month old from KG Lange and Sons weighing 775kgs and selling for 86.5ppk.

With an excellent show of over 1350 Hogs, trade remained firm with prices continuing to top £100. The top price per kilo went to an excellent pen of 10 from DT Sowersby of Etton, weighing 46kg and selling 213.00ppk (£96) to JB Fitton Ltd of Oldham. The top price per head went to a pen of 7 from TG Warriner of Pickering, weighing 60kg and selling for £104 (173.00ppk).
