TUESDAY 31st MAY 2016 MARKET REPORT

There was an increase in the number of cattle forward this week at Malton with a strong entry of heifers and an increase in the number of bulls forward, as butchers cattle and cows continue to be a firm trade. There was a good show of lambs this week as Hogg numbers draw to a close.

9 steers averaged 194.84ppk and topped at 209.50ppk (£1467)

15 young bulls averaged 164.22ppk and topped at 196.50ppk (£1268)

28 heifers averaged 198.08ppk and topped at **259.50ppk** (£1479)

11 OTM cattle topped at **162.50ppk (£1300)**

516 Spring Lambs averaged 196.01ppk and topped at £99.00 (220.00ppk)

246 Hogs averaged 127.64ppk and topped at £90.00

15 YOUNG BULLS

There were again more bulls through the ring this week at Malton with a range of weights through the ring.
