TUESDAY 2nd AUGUST 2016 MARKET REPORT

The start of the new month showed an increase in the number of stock in all departments with more entries than the previous week. There was strong trade for bulls which topped at 216.5ppk an increase of 21ppk from the previous week. There was an increase in the amount of lambs entered with the average price per kilo of 177.71ppk.

14 steers averaged 179.56ppk and topped at 228.50ppk (**£1588.08**)

20 young bulls averaged 191.09ppk and topped at 216.50ppk (**£1660**)

20 heifers averaged 211.15ppk and topped at 252.50ppk (£1465)

12 OTM cattle topped at 169.50ppk (**£1398**)

There was an increase in the entry of lambs this week with a strong trade all round as the average ppk nears 180ppk. The top price per kilo went to an excellent pen of 7 from G D Warters at Flixton, weighing 45kg and selling for 204.00ppk (£103) to Radford's Butchers from Sleights. The top price per head went to a pen of 3 from K Preston at Thornthorpe, weighing 60kg and selling for £100.00 (167.00ppk) to Worsley Wholesale Butchers at Sleights. A number of other pens topped 200ppk with a pen of 5 from S D & D Whitaker of Low, weighing 39kg and selling for 203.00ppk

(£79.00) to Worsley Wholesale Butchers at Briestfield. Also a pen of 7 from C H Foxton of West Ness did well, weighing 49kg and reaching 200.00ppk (£98.00) to A Traves & Son at Esrick.
