## **TUESDAY 16<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2016 MARKET REPORT**

With spring fast approaching there was a firm trade across all departments. Clean cattle averaged over 200ppk with some excellent beasts on show and another strong entry of heifers saw prices again top 250ppk. Lighter steers also sold well on the day. Hogs returned to the outdoor pens with fit pens continuing to be a good trade.

- 8 steers averaged 202.85ppk and topped at **243.50ppk** (£1362)
- 3 young bulls averaged 153.01ppk and topped at 171.50ppk (£1412)
- 25 heifers averaged 206.67ppk and topped at **251.50ppk** (£1556)
- 9 OTM cattle topped at 181.50ppk (£1093)
- 894 Hogs averaged **183.02ppk** and topped at £105 (228.00ppk)
- 95 cull ewes averaged £66.38 and topped at £84

### **3 YOUNG BULLS**

More bulls needed please with a limited number available this week at Malton. The top price per kilo went to a Lim bull from B Blackburn of Muston, weighing 550kg and selling for 171.50ppk (£943) to R Agar of Ilkley. The top price per head went to a Lim from JH Almond of Bempton, weighing 885kg and selling for £1412 to Cleveland Meat Co of Stockton on Tees.

### **8 STEERS**

There was a similar entry of steers this week with another improved trade as the average topped 200ppk. The top price per kilo went to an excellent BB steer from GI Marwood of Harome, weighing 540kg and selling for 243.50ppk (£1315) to Radford's Butchers of Sleights. The top price per head went to a BB from E E Wilkinson & Son of Langtoft, weighing 635kg and selling for £1362 (214.50ppk) to Worlsey Wholesale Butchers of Bristfield. Other steers to sell well included a Lim from the same home weighing 545kg and reaching 225.50ppk (£1229).

The top price per head went to a heavier BB heifer from RH Mason of Wold Newton, weighing 675kg and selling for £1556 (230.50ppk) to Worsley Wholesale Butchers of Briestfield. A Lim from DR Jackson of Carnaby, weighing 565kg reached 245.50ppk and a Lim from JR Gardiner of Carnaby, weighing 595kg sold for £1437. The top price per head went to a 30 month old CHX from JW Colling & Sons, weighing 685kg and reaching £1093 (159.50ppk). An 85 month old BB from Am & DE Stones of Ebberston reached 101.50ppk (£645).

### **894 HOGGS**

Hoggs returned to the outside pens this week as we approach spring and trade remained firm with good fit hoggs continue to top £100. The top price per kilo went to an excellent pen of 5 from M Ward & Son of Great Habton, weighing 46kg and selling for 228.00ppk (£105) to JB Fitton Ltd of Oldham. Another pen of 5 from the same home, weighing 45kg also sold for 228.00ppk. A pen of 3 from RH Green of Pickering also topped the price per head figure, weighing 60kg and reaching £105 (175.00ppk). A pen of 10 from FA Burton of Cottam, weighing 60kg, sold for £100 and a pen of 6 from KW & RJ Wilson of Ryton, weighing 57kg sold for £98.
